PLAYER

1. **"Club"** for the purposes of this membership / registration application and declaration means and includes the Noble Park Football Club Juniors, its directors, officers, members, servants or agents.
2. **Warning:** Participation in the game of football can be inherently dangerous. Serious injuries and / or accidents can develop or occur which may result in me being seriously injured. I have voluntarily read and understood this warning and accept and assume the inherent risks in participating in football training and competition activities.
3. **Exclusion of Liability:** Except where provided or required by law and such cannot be excluded, I agree that it is a term of my membership (if accepted) that the Club is absolved from all liability however arising from any Claims arising out of my membership and/or participation in any Club Activity.
4. **Release and Indemnity:** In consideration of the Club accepting my application for membership I:
 - (a) Release and forever discharge the Club from all Claims that I may have or may have had but for this release arising from or in connection with my membership and/or participation in any Club Activity;
And
 - (b) Indemnify and hold harmless the Club to the extent permitted by law in respect of any Claim by any person including but not only another member of the Club arising as a result of or in connection with my membership and/or participation in any Club Activity.

In this declaration **"Claims"** means and includes any action, suit, proceeding, claim, demand, damage, penalty, cost or expense however arising (including negligence, trespass to the person or for breach of implied terms in the sale of services under section 74 of the *Trade Practices Act (Cth) 1974*), but does not include a claim in respect of any action, suit, etc made by any person entitled to relief under a responding Club insurance policy or under the Club Constitution or any By-Laws.

Fitness to Participate: I declare that I am and must continue to be medically and physically fit and able to participate in any Club Activity. I am not and must not be a danger to myself or to the health and safety of others. I will immediately notify the Club in writing of any change to my fitness and ability to participate. I understand and accept that Club will continue to rely upon this declaration as evidence of my fitness and ability to participate.

CODE OF CONDUCT

PLAYER'S CODE OF CONDUCT:

- ❖ Play by the rules – the rules of the club and the laws of the game.
- ❖ Never argue with the umpire or other officials – without these people you cannot play football.
- ❖ Control your temper – verbal abuse of officials and sledging other players doesn't help you enjoy or win any games.
- ❖ Be a team player – it's a team game, treat it that way.
- ❖ Treat all other players, as you would like to be treated – fairly.
- ❖ Co-operate with your coaching staff, the umpires and teammates.
- ❖ Play for your enjoyment and to improve your skills.
- ❖ Don't use ugly remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability – many such comments are actually now illegal
- ❖ Remember you are a member of a club – your behavior reflects on the club.

Failure to abide by one or more of these codes may, at the discretion of the Noble Park Football Club Juniors Committee, impose penalties of suspension from participation in further matches, or expulsion from the club.

SPECTATORS CODE OF CONDUCT

- ❖ Remember you are there for the participants to enjoy the game.
- ❖ Encourage participation, but don't force it.
- ❖ Teach that enjoyment and mate ship is more important than winning.
- ❖ Never ridicule mistakes or losses - supporters are there to support not downgrade.
- ❖ Lead by example and respect all players, coaches, umpires, officials and spectators – physical or verbal abuse will not be tolerated.
- ❖ Recognize and respect all volunteers who are giving up their valuable time.
- ❖ Never publicly criticize umpires, coaches, officials – raise personal concerns with club officials in private.
- ❖ Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from football matches
- ❖ Refrain from loud, abusive and degrading heckling or barracking.
- ❖ Don't use ugly remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability – You will let your family down and yourself and many such comments are actually now illegal and you could be prosecuted.
- ❖ Under no circumstances will the physical handling of ANY child, umpire, official, spectator or other attendee at the club or grounds be tolerated.
- ❖ Remain in the spectator area. Do not go onto the ground during play, and stay out of the designated coaches area. It is the decision of the club that no spectator is permitted within 10 meters of coacher's boxes.
- ❖ Consumption of alcohol is not permitted at junior football or training. For all rules and penalties refer to the alcohol Management policy.

Failure to abide by one or more of these codes may, at the discretion of the Noble Park Football Club juniors committee, impose penalties of immediate ejection from the grounds, suspension from attending further matches, expulsion from the club and possibly league or in the worst case referred to authorities.
